

Annual Meeting of U.K.E.M.S

26th March, 1980 University of Exeter

1. Announcements were made of the dates of:-
 - (a) Next Annual Meeting in Canterbury.
 - (b) EEMS in Athens.
 - (c) Laboratory Workshop in Swansea.
 - (d) International Congress in Japan.

2. Dr. Parry reported upon the deliberations of the small committee appointed to discuss the study and evaluation of chemical mutations. The committee has decided to institute two new developments in the-activity of the society.
 - (a) The evaluation of a set of data as a paper exercise at the next annual meeting of the society. This exercise will be organised by D. Macgregor and Dr. Diana Anderson.
 - (b) The members of the society have agreed to test 2 compounds per year with the range of experimental systems available to the members. The data derived from this trial will be made available at the annual meeting and will be the subject of a detailed evaluation exercise. The exercise will be coordinated by a small committee composed of Dr. Colin Arlett Chairman, Dr. James Parry Secretary, Dr. John Ashby - and Dr. Maurice Coombs .

3. The Chairman announced the nominations for the new executive committee of the society. No further nominations had been received so the new committee was elected by acclamation. The new committee is therefore comprised of

7. The meeting closed at 1.30 p.m.


